General Data Protection Regulation

The South East Essex Railway Society's Data Protection Policy has been agreed by the Committee. The policy describes what data we capture and what we use it for, Your data is used to:-

- Deliver the Society's programme and other correspondence;
- Communicate with you by email and/or phone if you choose to provide this data;
- Enable you to choose which of postal address, email and telephone number are provided to other members in the membership directory;
- Manage your membership of the Society.

Data is restricted to that needed for the above purposes and comprises:-

- Your full name including title and initials;
- Your postal address;
- Your 'phone number if you have provided it;
- Your email address if you have provided it.

Data is captured on a legitimate interest basis in order that we can provide you with details of the Society's programme and other tangible benefits of membership and manage your subscription payments.

You have the right to see what data we hold on you and amend them if you wish.

We will delete your data if you leave the Society or if you ask us to.

We will not share your data with third parties without prior approval from you.

If at any time you need to know what data the Society holds or withdraw your permission for its use as decribed above, please contact a member of the Committee.
